Fully integrated archiving and retrieval system

Archiving is a key addition to the Pongrass Version 6 Editorial system.

Archiving shares the same browser based interface as News Editor with the same zero installation design.

Fast Search

You can search on publication, edition, date run, key word, author etc. Full indexed text search is available on editorial content.

Automatic Archiving

After an edition has been paginated and marked for archiving, export to the archive database is scheduled.

Pictures, text and other story elements are exported, and registered in the archive. PDF pages are registered and linked to archived page elements. The full text index is generated as part of the archiving process.
